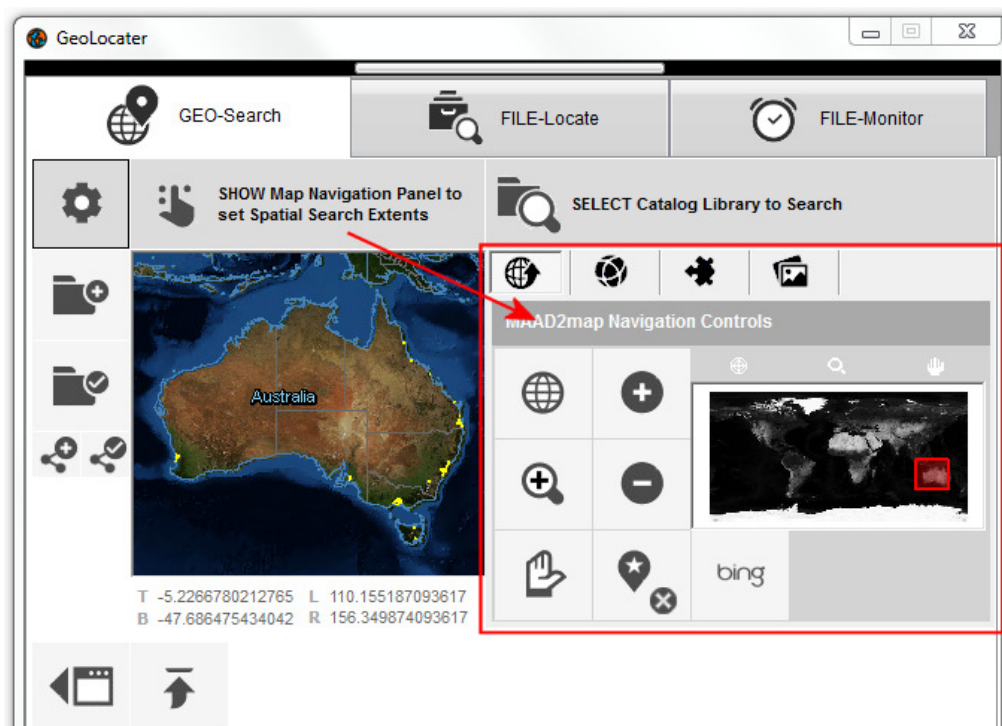


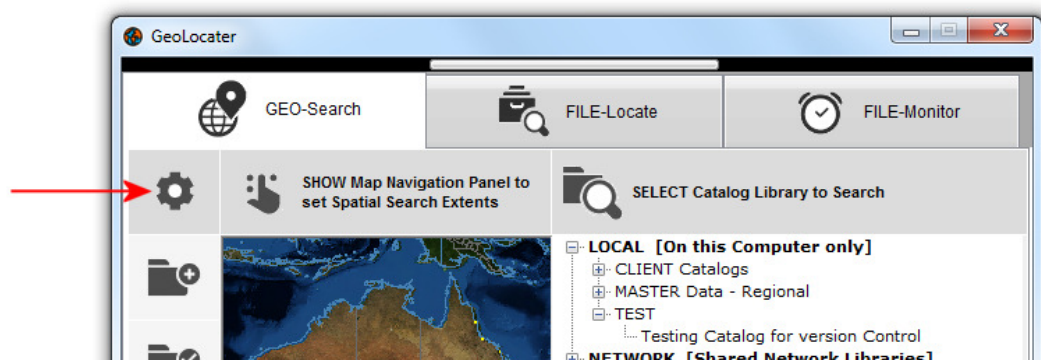
## KB3008: How to set the 'Catalog Library Listings' or the 'Spatial Search Map Navigation Options' as the active interface on system start.

This document outlines the process to set the active interface of either the listing for the Catalog Libraries (default) or Spatial Search Map Navigation Options interface on the system start.

This option was added in version 4.0.4.



1. To change, select the **Settings and Configuration** button from the **Geo-Search** tab.



2. From the **On-Start Config** tab, select the dropdown selection from **No** to **Yes** for the option **“Display the spatial search map buttons on system start (default catalog library interface)?”**
