

KB3009: How to change the default My Documents\MAAD folder to a NEW temporary folder of your choice?

MAAD2gO uses a temporary folder location for creating ad-hoc files and objects when the program is operating. The default location of this temporary folder is the current logged on users My Documents\MAAD directory. This temporary directory can now be changed to another folder of the users' choice. This document outlines the process to change temporary folder locations.

This option was added in version 4.0.4.

- 1. Manually, through File Explorer, create a new directory or folder on your PC.
- 2. Then, within the MAAD2gO program, select the **Change MAAD2gO Configuration** button from the MAAD2GO Administration tab.



- 3. From the MAAD2gO Configuration Interface, select the dropdown selection from No to Yes for the option "Use Temp Directory?"
- 4. Enter the **FULL path** (without a final \) of the **newly created temporary directory location**.
- 5. Select the SAVE Configuration Changes button.
- 6. For the changes to take effect and the program to use the new temporary folder location, the program needs to be **shut down and restarted**.
